FAMILY NEWS

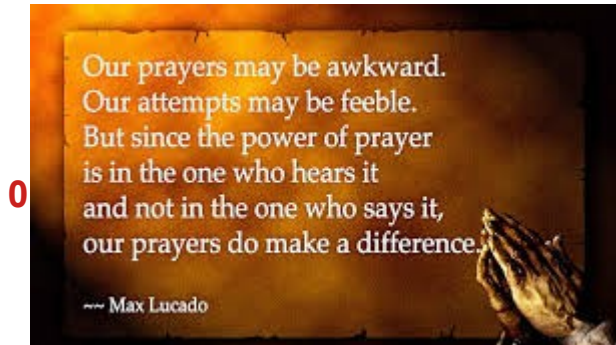
The church has sent \$2000 to both Fiji and Vanuatu to assist them after suffering from cyclone Harold and the Corona virus.. May God be with them.
